An AED is an Automatic External Defibrillator, which is described by the American Red Cross as a "medical device that can analyze the heart's rhythm and, if necessary, deliver an electrical shock, or defibrillation, to help the heart re-establish an effective rhythm." Sudden cardiac arrest is among the leading causes of death in the United States. More than 350,000 people will suffer a cardiac arrest this year. Currently the only way to restore a regular heart rhythm during cardiac arrest is to use an AED. Mound City Bank & the Linden Rescue Squad feel it is important to support the lives of their community & the surrounding areas.

The expense that comes along with purchasing an AED is roughly \$21,000.00. The Linden First Responders have been fundraising for the past year and will continue throughout the year.
