Mound City Bank Builds New Bank in Cuba City



Mound City Bank is now open at its new location at 117 W. Webster Street in Cuba City. The newly renovated full service bank features a 4,566 square foot, single story building, which includes a community room along with a 958 square foot basement. The project architect was Joe Bailie, Delta 3 Engineering and the general contractor was Brad Bierman, EPIC Construction.

Mound City Bank established its presence in Cuba City in 1992, opening a branch location on Main Street. In response to the community's increasing deposit and loan growth, Mound City Bank made the strategic decision to purchase the former Cardin's Pharmacy building site in 2023. The original building was expanded to accommodate the community room and basement. A spacious two lane drive-up was also added and equipped with a night depository and ATM. The new location opened for business on February 20, 2024.
